**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER**

**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM  
(EVENTS, BARKING AND DAGENHAM)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND WAITING AND  
LOADING) ORDER 2024**

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of their powers under Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called “the Act”) and of all other enabling and amending legislation and powers hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on each of the dates and at the times set out in Column 3 of Schedule 4 to this Order with regard to each event named in Column 2 of that Schedule and will remain in force for the period of the dates and times stated and may be cited as The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Events, Barking and Dagenham) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicular Traffic and Waiting and Loading) Order 2024.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided in Article 7 hereof, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle, including pedal cycles, to enter roads or any lengths of road specified in Column 3 of Schedule 1 during the dates and times of operation for the event named in Column 2 of that Schedule, the dates and times of operation of the named event being as specified in Column 3 of Schedule 4 for the event so named in Column 2 of that Schedule.
4. Save as provided in Article 7 hereof, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load on the footway or carriageway of any length of road specified in Column 3 of Schedule 2 during the dates and times of operation for the event named in Column 2 of that Schedule, the dates and times of operation of the named event being as specified in Column 3 of Schedule 4 for the event so named in Column 2 of that Schedule.
5. Save as provided in Article 7 hereof, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle (except for access where granted by marshals) to enter the lengths of road specified in Column 3 of Schedule 3 during the dates and times of operation for the event named in Column 2 of that Schedule, the dates and times of operation of the named event being as specified in Column 3 of Schedule 4 for the event so named in Column 2 of that Schedule.
6. The dates and times of operation referred to in Articles 3, 4 and 5 for each named event are as specified in Column 3 of Schedule 4 for the event so named in Column 2 of that Schedule.
7. Nothing in Article 3, 4 or 5 of this Order shall apply to:

- a. Any vehicle being used, in connection with the said events;
  - b. Any vehicle being used, by a statutory undertaker in an emergency where it is necessary by reason of emergency for that vehicle to have access to or to wait or load within the prohibited length of road at a time when the prohibition of access or prohibition of waiting and loading applies;
  - c. Any vehicle being used for Fire brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes; or
  - d. Anything done with the permission or under the direction of a police constable in uniform.
8. When Event No. 4 as specified in Column 1 of Schedule 4 is taking place no person shall cause any vehicle, including pedal cycles to travel in any direction other than specified in the following One-Way restrictions which shall be introduced:
- a. Margery Road from its junction with Bonham Road to its junction with Henshawe Road in an easterly direction.
  - b. Henshawe Road from its junction with Margery Road, in a southerly direction to its junction with Valence Wood Road.
9. Nothing in Article 8 of this Order shall apply to:
- a. Any vehicle being used, for Fire brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes; or
  - b. Anything done with the permission or under the direction of a police constable in uniform.
10. The provisions of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

3	The Big Weekender Build and Break	Road Closure on Valence Park from its junction with Becontree Avenue to its southern extent.
4	The Big Weekender (Event)	Road Closure on Valence Park from its junction with Becontree Avenue to its southern extent. Charlecote Road from its junction with Valence Wood Road to its northern extent. Warrington Road closed at its junction with Becontree Avenue.  Upon event egress, Becontree Avenue from its junction with Walnut Tree Road to its junction with Hitherfield Road.
5	Nagar Kirtan - Gudwara	Rolling closure on North Street from its junction with George Street to its junction with Gurdwara Way (Northern Relief Road (A124)). Gurdwara Way (Northern Relief Road (A124))

		from its junction with North Street to its junction with Longbridge Road roundabout. Fanshawe Avenue from its junction with Longbridge Road roundabout to its junction with Ilford Lane. Ilford Lane from its junction with Fanshawe Avenue to its junction with Victoria Road.
6	Remembrance Parade – Barking Park	Rolling closure westbound on Longbridge Road from its junction with Upney Lane, except for right turn access from South Park Drive. Longbridge Road from its junction with Aldersey Gardens to its junction with Station Parade, with junctions closed at Salisbury Avenue, Fanshawe Avenue, Cecil Avenue, and Wilmington Gardens. Eastbound on Gurdwara Way (Northern Relief Road (A124)) from its junction with Queens Road to the roundabout at its junction with Longbridge Road.

8	Remembrance Parade - Dagenham Parish Church	Rolling closure along Rectory Road from the northern property boundary of No. 10 Rectory Road to its junction with Church Elm Lane.
