THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (ALDERMAN AVENUE AND TALLOW CLOSE) AMENDMENT No. * ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Replace 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions with 2700mm x 2050mm cycle hangers at the following locations:
 - a. Alderman Avenue, east side, from a point 4 metres north of the northern property boundary of No.56 Alderman Avenue for 2.7 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Replace 'No waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm' restrictions with 2700mm x 2050mm cycle hangers at the following locations:
 - a. Tallow Close, south side, opposite No. 18 to 25 Tallow Close.
 - b. Tallow Close, south side, outside No. 94 Tallow Close.
