

# Road Traffic Acts

## THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (SELINAS LANE, DAGENHAM) AMENDMENT No. \* ORDER 202\*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions on **Selinas Lane**, south side, at the following locations along the new kerb layout:
  - a. From a point 130.5 metres west of its junction with Coppen Road for 7.7 metres in a westerly direction.
  - b. From a point 152 metres west of its junction with Coppen Road to a point 14 metres east of a point opposite the entrance to Mirravale Trading Estate Units 1 to 10.
  - c. From a point 1.5 metres east of a point opposite the entrance to Mirravale Trading Estate Units 1 to 10 for 13.3 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Introduce 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions on **Freshwater Road**, south-east side, from a point 15.5 metres west of a point opposite the entrance to Mirravale Trading Estate Units 1 to 10 for 12 metres in a westerly direction.
3. Revoke the 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions on **Selinas Lane**, south side, at the following locations:
  - a. From a point 18.5 metres west of a point opposite the entrance to Mirravale Trading Estate Units 1 to 10 to a point 123 metres west of its junction with Coppen Road.
