THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (OXLOW LANE, WEBBSCROFT ROAD AND RAINHAM ROAD NORTH, DAGENHAM) AMENDMENT No. 136 ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. Oxlow Lane, north side, from a point 6.5 metres east of the common boundary of Nos. 287 and 289 Oxlow Lane in an easterly direction for 13 metres.
 - b. Webbscroft Road, south side, from a point 10.2 metres west of its junction with Rainham Road North for 38.8 metres in a westerly direction.
 - c. Webbscroft Road, north side, from a point 23.4 metres west of its junction with Rainham Road North for 33.7 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Introduce 'No waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6.30pm' restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. Webbscroft Road, north side, from a point 10.9 metres west of its junction with Rainham Road North for 13 metres in a westerly direction.
3. Introduce a 'Goods vehicles loading only 6am-9pm 30mins No return within 2hrs' bay on Rainham Road North, west side, from a point 33.8 metres north of its junction with Oxlow Lane for 8.6 metres in a northerly direction.
4. Revoke the 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions on Rainham Road North, west side, from a point 33.8 metres north of its junction with Oxlow Lane for 11.2 metres in a northerly direction.

A copy of the Orders, which will come into force on Monday 4 November 2024 and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Council's website by visiting the following webpage <https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/parking/parking-area> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes' or available for inspection at the Adult Library, First Floor, Barking Learning Centre, Barking between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court
